Since last month, the House of Commons has been busy with many key pieces of government legislation, Private Member's Bills, and reports from the Auditor General.

On February 13<sup>th</sup>, I introduced by second Private Members Bill C-377, An Act to Amend the Parliament of Canada Act (need to know). This bill will formalize the process for Parliamentarians to request a SECRET security clearance from the Government of Canada. Bill C-377 does not guarantee an applicant will pass the vetting process and it does not guarantee the applicant will have access to classified information. If passed, this bill will increase Parliament's ability to take national security and intelligence issues seriously while facilitating Parliament's ability to not only hold the government to account but to increase Canadians' trust in our federal democratic processes and institutions. Additionally, this bill would reduce government waste by reducing the need for special committees. This past month, I also spoke to Bill C-35 on childcare. I highlighted numerous local statistics and feedback from childcare centres across the riding. Some of the major concerns included labour shortages, impacts on pre- and after- school programs, and the lack of childcare spaces available. The Liberal government's childcare program is also disproportionally assisting higher income parents as opposed to lower income Canadians. Earlier this month, the Auditor General released her report on the Liberal government's ArriveCAN app. This app was originally budgeted for \$80,000 but ballooned to 750 times the original price. The Auditor General still cannot determine the final cost of this app (estimates sit around \$60 million). The House of Commons passed our Conservative Opposition Motion to call on the Prime Minister to "*table in the House of Commons, no later than Monday, March 18, 2024, a report which details the complete direct and associated costs concerning the ArriveCAN app incurred to date..."* and "*call on the government to collect and recoup all funds paid to ArriveCAN contractors and subcontractors which did no work on the ArriveCAN app, within 100 days of this motion being adopted, and for the Prime Minister to table a report in the House demonstrating that taxpayer funds have been repaid.*" You can read the full Opposition Motion here: <a href="https://www.ourcommons.ca/members/en/votes/44/1/648?view=party">https://www.ourcommons.ca/members/en/votes/44/1/648?view=party</a>.


I also had the opportunity to participate on Veteran's Affairs committee to speak to a motion to explore political interference surrounding the Canadian National Afghan Memorial. Unfortunately, the Liberal members spent

With income tax season approaching, you will be receiving a tax guide from me in the mail to outline some of the benefits you may be entitled to and to provide you with contacts at the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) to assist you. I encourage you to take the time to read through it and fill out the included survey question. I have also received a number of questions regarding electronic HST/GST filing and new requirements for Bare Trusts, I'm working with a number of my colleagues to seek clarity from both the Minister's office and CRA. 

#### Canadian Dental Care Plan (CDCP)

Recently, the federal government announced the enrollment schedule for the CDCP. Starting in mid-December 2023, letters will be mailed to seniors aged 87 and above who may qualify, followed by those aged 77 to 86 in January 2024, then those aged 72 to 76 in February 2024 and those aged 70 to 71 in March 2024. These letters

will include a personalized application code and instructions on how to apply. Once you have applied and it is confirmed that you qualify, your information will be shared with Sun Life, who will enroll you in the CDCP. Sun Life will mail you a welcome package that will include the following information:

- Information on the CDCP
- Your member card
- Your coverage start date

The full application schedule is set out below:

Group	Applications open
Seniors aged 87 and above	Starting December 2023
Seniors aged 77 to 86	Starting January 2024
Seniors aged 72 to 76	Starting February 2024
Seniors aged 70 to 71	Starting March 2024
Seniors aged 65 to 69	Starting May 2024
Adults with a valid Disability Tax Credit certificate	Starting June 2024
Children under the age of 18	Starting June 2024
All remaining eligible Canadian residents	Starting 2025
